### June 2025 Monthly Release

NORTHBROOK, Ill., July 17, 2025 – The Allstate Corporation (NYSE: ALL) today announced estimated catastrophe losses for the month of June of \$619 million or \$489 million, after-tax. Catastrophe losses for June include 15 events with approximately 70% of the losses related to three wind and hail events. Total catastrophe losses for the second quarter of 2025 were \$1.99 billion or \$1.57 billion, after-tax.
